## A whole-school approach to high-quality literacy teaching



The programme continues through the school years, by extending the earlier phonics teaching with further spelling, grammar and punctuation concepts. Each year of teaching provides continuous revision and consolidation of topics taught in previous years. This enables children to spell and punctuate more accurately, use a wider vocabulary and have a clear understanding of how language works.

### Phonics (Reception)



Children are taught the 42 letter sounds, how to write them, how to blend the sounds for reading and how to identify the sounds in words for spelling and writing. Alongside this children learn about tricky words as well as being introduced to the alternative spellings of vowels.



### Grammar (Years 1-6)

Children are introduced to parts of speech to include nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions and conjunctions. Colours and actions are used to help children identify parts of speech in sentences.



The examples above show how children are taken through the various forms that verbs may take.

## Spelling (Years 1-6)


Children are initially taught one way of spelling a sound before gradually learning that the same sound can be represented in a number of different forms. They start with the common variations, before progressing to other, more unusual spelling patterns that occur as the children develop their vocabulary for reading and writing.



The examples above show how children are taken through the different spellings of the /ai/ sound.

## Punctuation (Years 1-6)

Children are introduced to punctuation concepts and continue to revise these throughout the school years. Starting with full stops and speech marks, children will then learn how to use exclamation and question marks, colons and semi-colons, hyphens, commas, bullet points and much more.



### Enables you to teach the 5 key skills needed for reading and writing.

#### 1. Learning the letter sounds

Children are taught the 42 main letter sounds. This includes alphabet sounds and digraphs, such as /sh/, /th/, /ai/ and /ue/.

#### 2. Learning letter formation

Using different multi-sensory methods, children learn how to form and write the letters.

#### 3. Blending

Children are taught how to blend the sounds together to read and write new words.

#### 4. Identifying the sounds in words

Listening for the sounds in words gives children the best start for improving spelling.

#### 5. Learning tricky words

Tricky words have irregular spellings and children learn these separately.

### Letter sound order

The sounds are taught in a specific order (not alphabetically). The first group has been chosen as it makes more simple three letter words than any other six letters. This enables children to begin building words as early as possible.






**Letter Sound: /sh/**

**Flashcards:** Revise the letter sounds already taught: /s/, /a/, /t/, /i/, /p/, /n/, /c/, /k/, /e/, /h/, /l/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /u/, /r/, /f/, /b/, /v/, /w/, /x/, /y/, /z/, /ch/, /sh/, /th/, /ph/, /ng/, /ai/, /oi/, /oa/, /oo/, /y/, /x/, /ch/.

**Storyline:** Mum is trying to get the babies to sleep. She gives them their bottles and short while they all shut their eyes, apart from one who starts to cry. "Shshshsh," Mum is rocking the baby gently. "Hush now. Don't wake up your brothers and sisters."

**Action:** The children place their index finger against their lips and make a continuous /shshshshsh/ sound.

**Letter formation:** The sound /sh/ is written with two letters. When two letters make one sound it is called a digraph. Show the children how to join the letters, coming back around the top and then across and up tall to where the next letter starts.

**Blending:** Blend the words on the sound sheet with the children: dish, shop, sheep, brush. Children point to the dot underneath each sound as they say it. More words from the word bank can be written on the board for extra blending practice.

**Identifying the sounds:** This activity is for aural segmenting only. Look at the three small pictures on the sound sheet. Say the words and then sound them out with the children, holding up a finger for each sound: f-i-sh, sh-e-p, sh-a-k. Say the sounds again, pointing to the dots under the words. Do some more segmenting, using short words from the word bank.

**Word bank:** ash, bash, cash, dash, dish, fish, hush, mash, rash, rush, shed, sheep, sheet, shin, ship, shock, shoot, shop, short, shut, shush, shell, shock, blush, brush, crash, crush, flush, flush, fresh, shelf, shift, shrug, smash, finish, polish, punish, shrimp, splash, shampoo, shopping, vanish, mushroom, selfish, paintbrush; sixteen books on a shelf.

**Sound sheet:** Encourage the children to form the letters correctly and to colour the pictures neatly when completing the sound sheet.

**Dictation:** Call out the sounds /sh/, /ch/, /x/, /y/ and ask the children to write the letters for each one. Then call out the following words: rash, shed, wish, sheet. For each one, ask children to listen for the sounds and write the word. Afterwards, sound out each word to the children, writing the letters on the board so that they can check their work.

**Tricky words:** Introduce the tricky word *fl*. Explain that this word is tricky because it starts with its letter name and not its sound. We say it is very shy, so it puffs itself up into its capital letter. Underline the word in purple on the board to show the tricky part. Pin up the Tricky Word Wall Flower for *fl*.

**Further ideas**

- Sing the /sh/ song from Jolly Songs.
- Make sheep with cotton wool fleeces.
- Make a shaker with two yogurt pots and some uncooked rice.
- Pin up the /sh/ section of the Wall Frieze.

Each lesson provides revision of the previous letter sounds taught before introducing the new sound with a story and action. The teacher's notes provide detailed guidance on how the lesson can be delivered, as well as further ideas and suggestions for reinforcing the teaching. A handy word bank ensures teachers have a selection of words that can be used for dictation.



#### Tips for teachers and parents

- Some English words have silent letters, such as the *-i-* in 'ignite', which are not pronounced when the word is read. In these books, silent letters are shown in faint type. Remind the child not to say the faint letters when blending the word.
  - The letter *-i-* is sometimes pronounced /z/, especially at the ends of words such as 'is' and 'his'. Children do not usually have trouble reading these words, but they might need some help and guidance at the beginning.
- An important part of becoming a confident, fluent reader is a child's ability to understand what they are reading. Below are some suggestions on how to develop a child's reading comprehension.
- Encourage the child to think about what might happen next. It does not matter whether the answer is right or wrong, so long as the suggestion makes sense and demonstrates understanding.
  - Pick out any vocabulary that might be new to the child and ask what *(s)he* thinks it means. If *(s)he* does not know, explain it and relate it to what is happening in the book.

**Teachers and parents**

An important part of becoming a confident, fluent reader is a child's ability to understand what they are reading. Below are some suggestions on how to develop a child's reading comprehension. Make reading a shared experience between you and the child. Try to avoid this book as a shared experience between you and the child. - Ask questions about the characters, the setting, the action and the meaning.

- Ask the child to describe what is happening in the illustrations.
- Relate what is happening in the book to any real-life experiences the child may have.
- Pick out any vocabulary that may be new to the child and ask what they think it means. If they don't know, explain it and relate it to what is happening in the book.
- Encourage the child to summarise, in their own words, what they have read.
