- An important part of becoming a contident, fluent reader is a student's start to understand what they are reading. Below are some suggestion one to device a student's reading comprehension. Nake reading to the student's student's reading comprehension. Nake reading uning is util the whete boots is used before tableing abcuit it. Cocasona stup at various intervals throughout the book to do the following: 4
- · Ask questions about the characters, the setting, the action, and the meaning
- Encourage the student to think about what might happen next. It does not matter if the answer is right or wrong, so long as the suggestion makes sense and demonstrates understanding;
- Ask the student to describe what is happening in the illustrations; Fletate what is happening in the book to any real-life expensions the student may have:
- Pick out any vocabulary that may be new to the student and ask what they think it means. If they don't know, explain it and relate it to what is happening in the book;
- Encourage the student to summarize, in their own words, what they have read.
